



I am proud to present the Annual Report for 2024–2025, a year of steady growth and meaningful service in elder care. With CSR support from Balaji Amines Ltd., we completed a modern Recreational Hall with a movie theatre and library, bringing joy and connection to our residents. We also opened our second branch, Amrutvel Care Center in Pirangut, Pune, in July 2024. This year, we welcomed 73 new patients at Solapur and 59 at Amrutvel. Health camps supported early treatment, while organic farming met 30% of our vegetable needs. We thank all staff, donors, and supporters for helping us serve with dignity and care.

I am pleased to share the annual summary for 2024–2025, a year of strong progress in care, outreach, and sustainability. We served around 1,000 patients, focusing on both physical and mental health. Our team conducted health camps for cancer, diabetes, blood pressure, dental and eye care, along with regular blood tests for early diagnosis. Mental well-being was strengthened through routine therapy sessions. Recreational activities such as bhajans, music, comedy shows, and a new movie theatre brought joy and connection to residents. We improved personalized care with a 4:1 staff-to-patient ratio and ensured sustainability by balancing free and paid care. We thank our team and supporters for their continued trust and support.

3.

We plan to build a peaceful temple with a meditation hall, giving residents a spiritual and calming space for reflection, connection, and inner peace.

4.

We are strengthening our healthcare system by establishing a Mini ICU at Adhar Care Center to provide timely, critical care during medical emergencies.




OUR MISSION

A movie theatre and a library have been developed within the recreational hall for community use.




At ADHAR Care Center, 36 new bedridden patients with chronic illnesses receive the necessary care and ongoing assistance.



The Amrtvel Care Center at Pirangut, Pune was established in July 2024 as the second branch of the Trust, with the aim of extending its care and support services.



We welcomed 59 new patients to our Amrutvel Center in Pune, expanding our care services.



A.D. Joshi ANAND SAHJEEVAN currently provides residence to 22 elderly individuals, fostering a caring and vibrant community environment.

At Adhar Ghar, we supported 15 patients by providing shelter, medical care, counselling, hygiene support, medication, and long-term rehabilitation.

From Darkness to Dignity – Mr. Abhay Jadhav’s Journey

When Mr. Abhay Jadhav arrived at Adhar Care Center in late 2024, he was burdened by years of misunderstood mental illness and emotional suffering. For over a decade, he had been prescribed nearly 20 tablets a day, which damaged his physical health and failed to bring relief. He lived in shifting identities, often dressing and behaving as a policeman, postmaster, or bus conductor, fully believing these roles to be real. A large metal trunk filled with costumes became his guarded source of identity and comfort.

Abhay was also aggressive and self-harming, leaving his family helpless despite prolonged treatment. At Adhar, our team looked beyond symptoms and re-evaluated his care with compassion and patience. His medication was carefully reduced, bringing clarity and calm. Gradually, the imagined roles, aggression, and dependency on the trunk faded.

Today, Abhay is stable, peaceful, and grounded—having rediscovered his dignity, identity, and place in the world.

Reclaiming Freedom – Mr. Arun Gadgil’s Journey

At 74, Mr. Arun Gadgil lived an active, independent life, riding his scooter daily and enjoying retirement. He visited our old age home hoping to join a community of peers, but fate intervened when a fall caused a fracture to his right femur, leaving him bedridden after hip replacement surgery.

He arrived at our physiotherapy unit discouraged and depressed, burdened by regret and self-blame. Our physiotherapy and counseling teams supported him with empathy, guiding him through gentle exercises, strength training, and balance work, while restoring his confidence step by step.

Within 15 days, Arun began sitting and walking with a walker. Over the next six weeks, his strength and spirit steadily returned. Soon, he walked independently once more.

Today, Arun has resumed daily activities at home and is preparing to join our old age home community—proof that compassionate care can help reclaim freedom at any age.






Adhar Vishwastha Sanstha has received an income of **Rs 1,28,87,290** in the Financial Year 2024-25.


Adhar Vishwastha Sanstha's total expenses amounted to **Rs 1,28,67,177** in the Financial Year 2024-25.
